### Students Supporting Israel

Our work with Students Supporting Israel on campus is an ongoing effort. Most recently, the Students for Justice for Palestine have been very aggressive on campus. They set up a table saying "Intifada" and had a week-long campaign called "Break the Butchers," which is a call to hold the board of trustees accountable for supporting Israel in any way. They even had a post on their Instagram page saying "Death to the Occupation/Death to the Collaboration," which is basically calling for death to Zionists and anyone who supports them. ## Frank Turek Event/Aftermath of Charlie Kirk's Murder



Many have reached out to me, asking if I am concerned about safety. The answer is that we are more aware of it, but nothing is really going to change for us. This has only strengthened our commitment to discussions with students. It is indeed a battle of worldviews!

The day after Charlie was shot, a student told us on campus that he deserved it. I asked, "Why?" She replied, "Because he was a Nazi." People who use the words "Fascist" and "Nazi" have no idea what they are talking about.

As a mentor to Charlie, Dr. Frank Turek was very close to him. Sadly, he was about 15 feet away from Charlie when he was murdered. He was even in the car with Charlie after he was shot and was trying to revive him. He has been all over the news and spoke at the funeral.

Frank speaks on college campuses, and he has been to OSU several times. He will be back on November 3 to speak on the topic "If God, Why Evil?"
