HaMashiach, Jesus the Messiah:

Thank you for your support, prayers, and continued invitations—albeit canceled because of this COVID-19 pandemic. Although the pandemic has prevented me from speaking *in churches*, it has not affected my ability *to speak through technology*. God has enabled me to reach people in ways I could never have imagined. I must admit, I am not as technologically savvy as many of my counterparts, but sometimes circumstances warrant learning.

Granted that there is no substitute for the intimate fellowship enjoyed with person-to-person contact, my sermon series through the Book of Revelation has managed to attract over 900 listeners this past week alone. My average, in-person, church attendance is probably only around 100-150! A professor at Moody Bible Institute and his family even surprised us with a visit to our live Zoom meeting after listening to a sermon I preached in southern Illinois on Facebook. I suspect no matter what the future holds, and I sure hope it brings us all back together soon, using Zoom, Facebook, and the likes, are here to stay.

Since my last letter, I have been able to witness to several people as well as disciple believers in how to use the Internet to evangelize through their own meetings. We have created interactive evangelistic meetings where questions are posted, and then we come together for group discussions.

In an effort to build bridges between believers and non-believers, we will be mass-mailing

postcards, asking people questions such as: “Why does a good God allow suffering?” “Is Yeshua (Jesus) the only way?” “What happens after death?” “Is Jesus God’s Son?” “Is the Bible true?” “God, are You really there?” These questions are designed with the aim toward a special invitation to hear answers at our live interactive Zoom meetings. I draw people to each of these questions through promotions on websites, Google searches, local and regional mailings, and other avenues in order to raise them before others. We will make places available for the reader to contact us about special situations or any additional questions. We will also offer a personal Zoom meeting with me when if the reader prefers that type of contact.

As I am sure you are aware, these times have been anything but stable. Speaking in churches, my primary function with my mission organization, C.J.F. Ministries, is not permitted or is currently significantly limited. As a result, I humbly ask for your continued support now more than ever.
