GOD IS MOVING IN CONNECTICUT

Since my last newsletter, I have had the opportunity to share my story in Stonecroft meetings in Connecticut, New York, and Massachusetts. Stonecroft was established in 1938 by Helen Duff Baugh in San Jose, California, as a prayer group focused on sharing God's love with women. The ministry has since expanded its focus and is praying for new groups to be formed in every zip code in the US and in every city, town, and village worldwide. Each chapter holds a monthly public meeting at a restaurant, featuring a speaker and a guest who shares their spiritual journey, which is where I have shared my own story. I have also met two Jewish people and prayed with a third to accept Yeshua as her Messiah: a secular Jewish woman from Michigan, a Jewish woman from Croatia, and a member of Simchat Yisrael. The woman from Simchat has agreed to be discipled, and we are reading my book, *Messiah in Jewish Scripture*. We meet once a week after lunch on Saturdays. I hope you will join me in prayer for her and for the other Jewish woman I recently met.
