Born Again Anniversary Celebration

This summer, I celebrated the 40th anniversary of my born-again birthday. The Lord showed me a beautiful song by Lauren Daigle that could be my celebratory song. A line in the song was especially fitting. It says, "I don't know who I'd be if I didn't know You; I'd probably fall off the edge!" I was able to use this personal celebration as a springboard for conversation with unbelievers in which I gave glory to God by testifying of His faithfulness throughout the years and how He's the One who has brought great healing to my heart as well as direction and meaning to my everyday life. I also choreographed a dance to the song. Praise God! He opened up an opportunity to share it, along with a spoken testimony, at a secular "open mic" night where about 60 attendees got to see and hear that the Lord is good!



Stating a line in a song that I agree with (or disagree with) is a great way to get some spiritual content into a conversation. Another example in that song is a line that says, "I don't know where I'd ao if You ever let go, so keep me held in Your hands." When I think of that line. it reminds me that mv confidence and faith are in the surety that God is with me all

the time and that He will never, ever let me go! I shared with quite a few unbelievers that if you can trust anyone not to let go, certainly God would be the most trustworthy! Usually, they nod or tilt their head when they consider that logic! So many people "believe" in God, which means they believe that there is a God, but they keep Him mentally in a proverbial box that has no connection with their day-to-day life.

Leading and Teaching Messianic Worship Dance

This was the 4th summer I attended Ariel Ministry's School of Messianic Jewish Studies as the Dance Leader. I am greatly encouraged to see how this annual ministry has developed. There is a core of women who participate every year, and this year, I could really see the progress we have made in having a strong foundational repertoire that everyone knows and in being more synchronized and close-knit as a group. Because of that, new participants were better able to fit right in and quickly learn the dances. Let me assure you that as the leader, I don't just teach the steps. Knowing the steps is great, but I emphasize teaching people how to experience and express worship as they dance.



I also taught a special session for the children and youth, many of whom joined the adults in our Sunday night and Shabbat worship. One darling young girl was sweet enough to write me a note of thanks for teaching her to dance. This is an answer to a prayer I have prayed numerous times through the years that God would use me to inspire young people to use their gifts for His glory.
